LESSONS – SUMMER 2017

The summer riding lessons are divided into two semesters of five weeks each. Lessons take place in the cool of the early morning and evening.

SEMESTER DATES

First Semester: June 26 – July 29
Second Semester: July 31 – September 2

KINDERIDE

Children up to age seven (or until first grade) are introduced to the basics of riding in the Kinderide program. Weekly half-hour lessons help children gain confidence, improve balance, increase coordination, and develop self-control. Kinderiders are led on ponies or horses trained for lesson use. Lessons are private or in small groups. The semester calendar and tuition rates apply.

NEW MAKE-UP LESSON POLICY

In the past we have allowed students to re-schedule missed lessons with no limitation. Unfortunately this has resulted in extreme difficulty in re-scheduling lessons toward the end of the semester. With much regret we have to impose a two lesson limit per student for make-up lessons. Thank you for your understanding and compliance.

TUITION

Semester tuition rates are based on weekly, hour-long group lessons:

One summer semester:

\$259 - - paid in full with registration by June 22

\$259 - - paid in full with registration by June 22 and

\$259 - - due by July 27.

\$469 - - paid in full by June 22.

ABSENCES

Please call the office if you have to miss a lesson, so that the instructors will know which horses to have ready.

PAY-BY-THE-LESSON and TRIAL LESSONS

Riders who cannot attend lessons on a regular, weekly basis, or who want to take a trial or “brush-up” lesson may enroll and pay by the lesson (\$65 per lesson). The first payment is due with your registration.

PRIVATE AND SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS

Private and semi-private lessons are ideal for students with their own horses, or for students who want extra personalized help with their riding. Please schedule at least 4 days in advance. One-hour private lessons are \$95 and semi-private lessons are \$75 per person.

PLEASE! REGISTER BY JUNE 14

As the schedule changes each semester, students must register each semester. We schedule registrations as they are received. Register early to help insure your time choice. Forms with payment should be in the office by June 14. Late registrations will be scheduled if there is a space available in a suitable class. The staff tries to schedule each student for the first choice of time requested. Please list a second choice in case your first choice is not available. Riders will be called after June 14 to verify lesson times.

HORSEMANSHIP AND RIDING

Horse grooming, tacking up, trail rides, and an occasional unmounted lesson are part of the Woodedge horsemanship and riding experience.

PROPER RIDING ATTIRE

All students enrolled in ANY Woodedge riding program MUST wear a certified ASTM-SEI approved riding helmet.

Long, ankle-length pants or jeans and boots with a textured sole and a 1” heel are also required. Contact the office for guidance.

BULLETIN BOARDS

Remember to check the bulletin boards to keep updated throughout the semester.

Please leave pets at home or in your car.

PARKING

Please park as near the barn as possible.
