MAKE-UP/ BONUS LESSON

An extra week of lessons is scheduled for May 30 – June 5 as a make-up lesson, or as a **bonus lesson** for those who have not missed any lessons. All students should plan to attend! The extra lesson is provided for a make up lesson (excludes pay-by-the-lesson plan) and it will be held at the regular lesson time.

No other make-up lessons will be arranged

PLEASE! REGISTER BY MARCH 1

As the schedule changes each semester, students must register for each semester. We schedule registrations as they are received. Register early to help insure your time choice. Forms with payment should be in the office by March 1. Late registrations will be scheduled if there is space in a suitable class. The staff tries to schedule each student for the first choice of time requested. Please list a second & third choice in case your first time choice is not available. Students will be called after March 10 to verify lesson times.

TUITION

Semester tuition rates are based on weekly, hour-long group lessons:
\$769 - - paid in full with registration
or
\$779 - - paid in two installments:
\$300 with registration and \$479 balance due by April 20

PAY-BY-THE-LESSON and TRIAL LESSONS

Riders who cannot attend lessons on a regular, weekly basis, or who want to take a trial or “brush-up” lesson may enroll and pay by the lesson (\$71 per lesson). The first payment is due with your registration.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are ideal for students with their own horses, or for students who want extra personalized help with their riding. Please schedule at least 4 days in advance. Rate: \$125 per hour

TUITION DISCOUNT

A \$35 discount is given to the second and other members of a family enrolling for a full semester of lessons. This discount does not apply to pay by the lesson students.

ABSENCES

Please call the office if you have to miss a lesson, so that the instructors may schedule accordingly. At Woodedge we ride everyday regardless of the weather.

HORSEMANSHIP and RIDING

Horse grooming, tacking up, trail rides, and an occasional unmounted lesson are part of the Woodedge horsemanship and riding experience. Group lessons typically consist of 3-5 students.

PROPER RIDING ATTIRE

All students enrolled in ANY Woodedge riding program **MUST wear a certified ASTM-SEI approved riding helmet**. Long, ankle-length pants or jeans and boots with a 1” heel and textured sole are also required.

KINDERIDE

Children up to age seven (or until first grade) are introduced to the basics of riding in the Kinderide program. Weekly half-hour lessons help children gain confidence, improve balance, increase coordination, and develop self-control. Kinderiders are led on ponies or horses trained for lesson use. Lessons are private or in small groups. The semester calendar and tuition rates apply.

GIFT CERTIFICATES and APPAREL

Riding lessons make a wonderful present any time of year. Gift certificates and Woodedge shirts, vests, tote bags, and sweatshirts are available in the office.

BULLETIN BOARDS

1. No suit shall be instituted by the student or the parents or guardian of a student, jointly or severally, against any owner or employee of the School, to recover damages or loss actually or allegedly resultant to parents of the student or to either of them by reason of any injury or fatality which, while on the premises or off the premises, either for instruction or in connection with instruction, such students shall sustain.
2.
