RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. EARLY ENTRIES APPRECIATED! POST ENTRIES will be will accepted only if made at least one class in advance and will incur a \$5 late entry fee.
- 2. NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS will be subject to a \$25 processing fee.
- 3. STABLING comprises 200 permanent indoor stalls in well-ventilated barns, equipped with doors and state-of-the-art rubber flooring. \$100 FOR THE SHOW. Day stalls are \$60. Stall information call 856.235.5623.
- 4. DOGS should be left at home! If you bring your dog, KEEP IT ON A LEASH!
- 5. REFUNDS will be made only on receipt of a veterinarian's certificate, which must be presented prior to the start of the division in which the horse was entered. NO REFUNDS ON STALLS FOR ANY REASON!
- 6. MANAGEMENT reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes should the best interests of the show or the rules require it.
- 7. SCHOOLING will be permitted only in areas provided. No schooling in the show rings except as a ticketed schooling session. Tickets are \$10. SCHOOLING AVAILABLE ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY EVENING \$30 PER HORSE.
- 8. ARENA SIZES: Indoor HEATED Arena 150' x 300'; Outdoor Arena 150' x 300'. All competition and schooling areas footing consists of sandy loam mixed with clay. All will be irrigated and dragged flat frequently.
- **9. PRIZE MONEY** will be awarded the day of the show.
- 10. QUESTIONS not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by Management, whose decisions shall be final. ALL NOTICES will be posted in the horse show office.

The Jockey Club created the Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) to encourage the retraining of Thoroughbreds into other disciplines upon completion of careers in racing or breeding. T.I.P. offers sponsorship for Thoroughbred-only classes and divisions, high point Thoroughbred awards at open horse shows and competitions, year end Performance Awards, a Thoroughbred of the Year Award and a Young Rider of the Year Award.

From the first T.I.P. event at Red Hills International Horse Trial in Florida on March 8, 2012 through the end of 2018, there were more than 4,490 horse shows and events with T.I.P. classes or awards held in 50 states and Canadian provinces. More than 41,500 eligible Thoroughbreds participated in these shows and events, competing for thousands of ribbons, hundreds of prizes and thousands of dollars in prize money simply for being a registered Thoroughbred.

In 2019, more than 1,300 sponsored horse shows will be offering awards for Thoroughbreds in 42 states and 6 Canadian provinces and in virtually every imaginable discipline.

Thoroughbreds are versatile athletes, which makes them ideally suited for any number of disciplines beyond the racetrack. T.I.P. helps showcase the breed's many talents at all levels of competition and encourages the retraining of Thoroughbreds once they have finished their racing or breeding career.

T.I.P. recognizes and rewards the versatility of the Thoroughbred through sponsorship of Thoroughbred classes and high point awards at sanctioned horse shows and through two annual awards: the T.I.P. Thoroughbred of the Year Award and the T.I.P. Young Rider of the Year Award.

For purposes of eligibility for all T.I.P. classes and awards, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book approved by The Jockey Club and the International Stud Book Committee.

In order to participate in a T.I.P. class or be eligible for a T.I.P. award, owners and riders must obtain a T.I.P. Number. Riders and owners should provide their T.I.P. Number with their entry AND at the time of their registration to ensure they are included by the show organizers in consideration for the awards. It is the responsibility of the owner/rider to ensure that the horse show knows the horse is eligible for awards.

The Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Hunter Award will be given to the Hunter Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Hunter classes, and the Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Jumper Award will be given to the Jumper Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Jumper classes. A high point ribbon will be provided for each award.

Open to riders of all ages. It is an equitation division with points to follow the rider. Riders must not have won three (3) blue ribbons in any performance or equitation classes in any shows, including Breed, Western, Pony Club, Eventing, with the exception of 4-H shows and lead line classes.

CLASS #311 BEGINNER RIDER – WALK, TROT – Judged at a walk and trot in both directions of the ring.

CLASS #312 BEGINNER RIDER – WALK, TROT, CANTER – Judged at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring.

CLASS #313 BEGINNER RIDER – OVER FENCES – Individual test to be ridden over a course of at least four cross rails not to exceed 18" in height.

OUTREACH MINI-STIRRUP SECTION – E.C.S.J.

Open to riders 10 years of age and under who have never shown over fences at a horse show. Riders who enter this division may not enter any other class in which they are required to canter or jump

Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies with suitability to count. Ponies must possess a valid ECSJ or USEF measurement card.

CLASS #331 PLEASURE HORSE/PONY – May be split into two classes. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. Suitability to purpose considered. Judged as a pleasant mount with true road and trail qualities. Disposition, manners, and responsiveness to count.

CLASS #332 CROSS COUNTRY PLEASURE – Same as Pleasure Horse/Pony, but must be tested by at least one of the following: Jump two 18" fences; back readily; stand quietly while rider mounts and dismounts; hand gallop. May be further tested at the judge's discretion.

CLASS #333 BRIDLE PATH HACK – To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Must be tested at a hand gallop; stop and back readily; walk off on loose rein; rider may be asked to mount and dismount.

CLASS #334 PLEASURE JUMPING – To perform over a course of four 18" cross rails. Disposition, manners, and responsiveness to count.
