2025 RIDING DAY CAMP

The staff at Woodedge Riding Camp is already looking forward to its 63rd season. Woodedge is noted for excellence in teaching horsemanship to its campers in a friendly and SAFE environment.

FACILITIES

Situated on 28 acres, Woodedge has several riding rings, an indoor arena for riding in inclement weather, and lots of open space.

DAILY PROGRAM

Campers usually ride twice daily: a riding lesson in the morning, and a "fun" activity, trail ride or games in the afternoon. For mounted lessons, campers are grouped by riding level. Other activities that round out the day include "theory lessons" to teach campers about the care and handling of horses.

HORSES

Approximately 20 horses and ponies, trained for use in teaching, are stabled at Woodedge. Each camper is matched with a "project horse" to care for during the two week session.

CAMPERS

Boys and girls ages seven to fifteen, from beginners to advanced riders, enjoy the camp.

LUNCH

Campers bring their own lunch (refrigeration is available). There are water/soft drink machines at the stable.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents are responsible for arranging transportation to and from camp. Many find it convenient to form carpools. Campers should arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 each morning. Please notify the office if camper will be absent. Pick-up time is 3:30 p.m.

DAILY SCHEDULE

Monday – Thursday, 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

CAMP CALENDAR

There are four two-week sessions:

- 1 June 30-July 3 / July 7-10
- 2 July 14-17 / July 21-24
- 3 July 28-31 / August 4-7
- 4 August 11-14 / August 18-21

REGISTRATION and FEE

Woodedge can accept only a limited number of campers for each two-week session.

Please return the <u>completed registration form and</u> <u>deposit</u> as early as possible to insure getting the dates you want.

Please indicate a first and second choice of sessions. SORRY! We can not accommodate split/half sessions. We cannot accept phone registrations.

The fee for each two-week session is \$995. A deposit of \$495 must accompany each registration form. The balance of \$500 is due on or before the first day of each camp session. If a camper enrolls for more than one session, a deposit of \$495 is required for each session. Deposits are not refundable, but can be applied as a credit to another Woodedge camp or lesson.

CAMP CURRICULUM

Staff members teach the campers good, basic -- and safe -- horsemanship. Besides learning to ride, campers learn to:

- * Understand the nature of the horse and how to work with it.
- * Act responsibly in caring for the horse and its equipment.
 - * Practice safety measures on and around horses.

Campers gain a solid foundation in the riding basics essential to having a safe and enjoyable time on horseback.

PROPER ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

Riding is one of the first activities of the day so campers should arrive ready to ride. **Students enrolled in any riding program MUST wear their own certified, ASTM-SEI approved riding helmet.** Long, ankle-length pants or jeans and boots with a 1" heel and textured sole are also required. For non-riding activities campers may change into shorts and sneakers. Campers should bring plenty of water on hot days.

STAFF

Bob Allen, Camp Administrator, is a nationally recognized riding instructor, show judge, trainer and speaker. He has served ARICP (American Riding Instructor Certification Program) as national panel chairman since 1984. Staff members are experienced in teaching riding and in working with young people.

CAMP HORSE SHOW

On the last day of each two-week camp session, campers participate in an informal horse show. Family and friends are welcome to attend!
